New vowels: ך and ם. Both make the "e" sound as in "me"



אִמָּה

ima, mother



בִּימָה

bimah, the raised platform in the synagogue from which the Torah is read and services led.

ה and ך are sounded consonants when they are immediately followed by a vowel. So, ה would make an "H" sound and ך would make a "Y" sound when they are immediately followed by a vowel.

When ה and ך are not followed by a vowel, they help the vowel.
