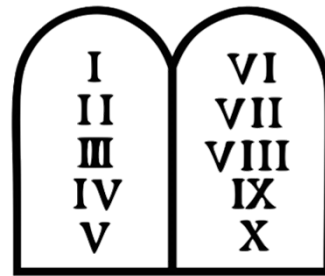


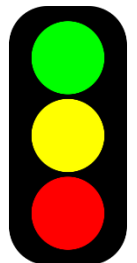
I am delighted that your child is in my classroom this year. I have developed a classroom management plan which affords every student guidance in making good decisions about his or her behavior and thus an opportunity to learn in a positive, nurturing classroom environment. Your child deserves the most positive educational climate possible for his or her growth, and together we can make a difference in this process. The plan below outlines our classroom commandments and positive rewards for appropriate behavior.

Classroom Commandments:

- ✧ Arrive to class on time and enter and exit the classroom in a respectful and orderly way
- ✧ Bring necessary books and materials to class
- ✧ Follow directions the first time they are given
- ✧ Raise hand to talk and wait to be called upon
- ✧ Listen respectfully when others speak
- ✧ Complete class assignments and homework in a timely fashion
- ✧ Stay in seat during class unless directed otherwise
- ✧ Students are encouraged to use the lavatory before class or during break time to minimize their time out of class
- ✧ Respect the classroom environment, its furnishings, equipment and work done by other students
- ✧ Follow general synagogue rules and policies



To encourage students to follow our commandments, there will be a constant color monitoring chart. Every student begins the day in the green. If there is an issue with behavior, he or she will move down to a warning level of yellow. If there is a second warning, he or she will move to red, and a final one to black. The black zone will warrant a phone call home. Students who remain in the green for the entire class will be rewarded with a chip. They may trade 5 chips in for a prize from my prize box.
